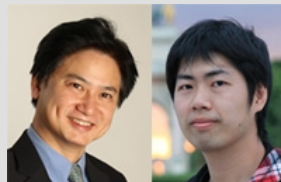

Engineering Scholar Wins State Natural Science Award



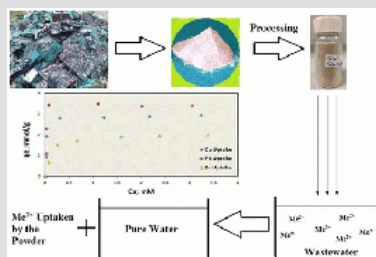

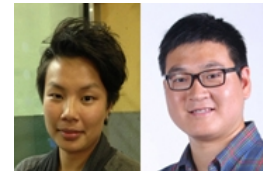
Electronic Waste as Cost-effective Innovative Adsorbent to Clean Wastewater

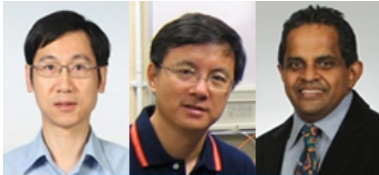
