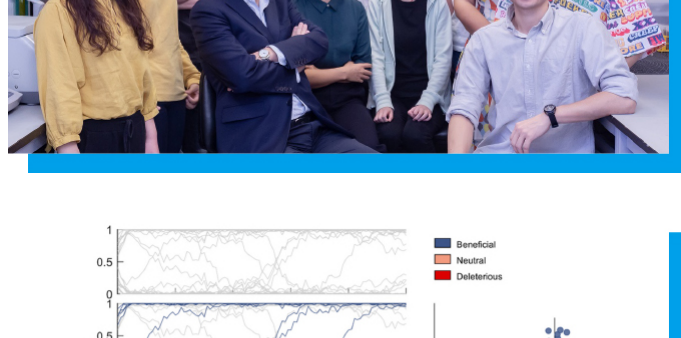
Prof. WANG Jiguang Marries Math with Biology to Help Find Cure to Rare Brain Cancer

Novel Cathode Design Significantly Improves Performance of Next-Generation Battery

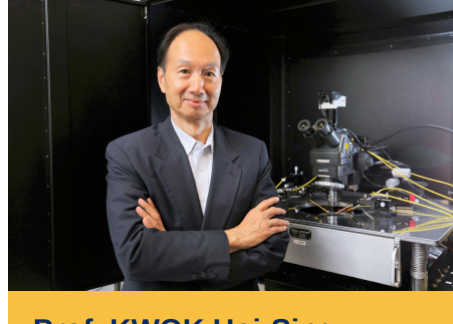
Prof. ZHAO Tianshou's research marks a big step towards the practical use of lithium-sulfur batteries.

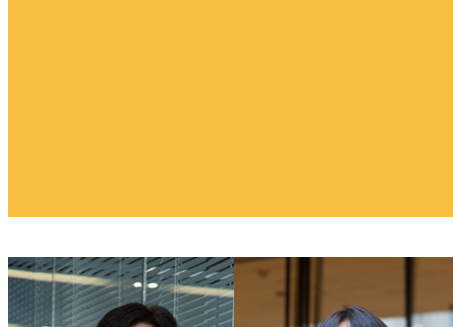

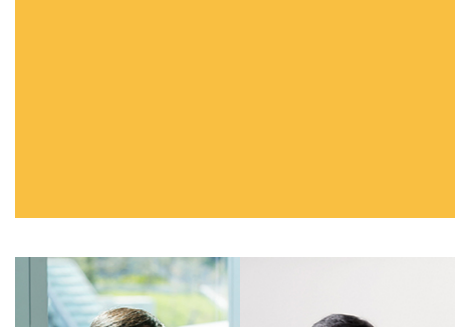

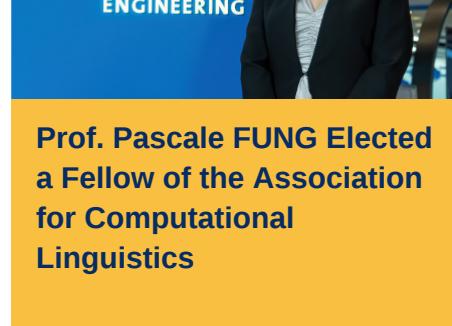

The team was commended by the judges for their highest-speed robots in the competition and superb and futuristic presentation.

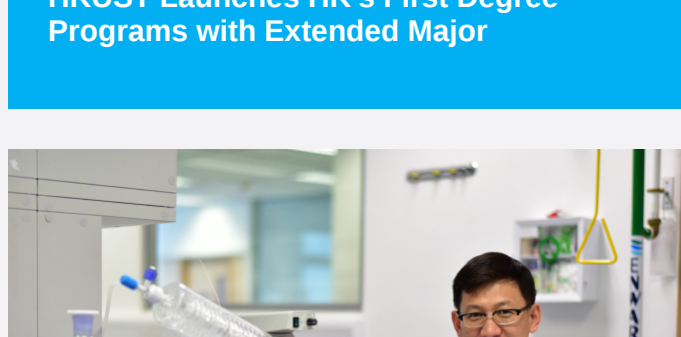

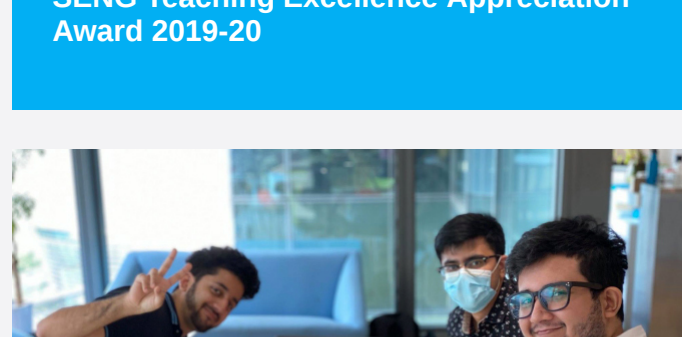

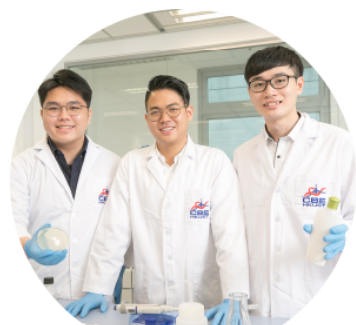
