Course Title
Academic and Professional Development I (Spring 22-23)

Course Description

A compulsory, one year course for Computer Engineering students only. This course is intended to offer advice to students on academic and professional matters, and to improve the students' communication skills. This will be achieved through: (1) Small student group meetings with an assigned advisor; (2) Professional and academic seminars, and (3) Social activities. Graded P or F.

List of Topics

Each student is assigned a CSE/ECE faculty advisor who meets with them twice a year (once in Fall term, once in Spring term) on an individual/group basis. Other activities including orientation dinner, career talks and workshops organized by the program.

Statement of Objectives/Outcomes

Upon successful completion of this course, students will have had:

- the opportunity to discuss academic and professional matters of both general and individual concern with their advisors.
- the opportunity to express their views on matters related to their study of computer engineering.
- practice with English communication, in speaking and listening, on both academic and non-academic topics.
