- 1. Cover letter (why are you interested in this event? Why shall you be selected for this event? How would you define peace? What can you do to promote peace-building? What do you hope to achieve as a humanitarian affairs peace ambassador?)
- 2. CV
- 3. Transcript
- 4. English poof, if any

Students nominated by the School of Engineering will be reimbursed for their economy class roundtrip ticket between HK and Bangkok (up to HK\$3,000) and summit registration fee (up to HK\$7,000). The *reimbursement will be issued upon completion of the event. Students are required to submit their pictures and report. All students must be fully vaccinated for COVID-19 AND meet the requirements of the HKSAR Vaccine Pass before commencing this event, with no exceptions granted under any situation.

*Air ticket and registration fee will not be reimbursed if withdrawal is due to personal reasons.
