

# International Summer Research Sponsorship Program

The sponsorship is designed to provide engineering undergraduates the opportunity to conduct research projects in the overseas institutions, while getting a taste of cultural exposure.

# **Eligibility:**

- 1. UG Students with a first major in the School of Engineering at HKUST;
- 2. Maintain active registration status but not in their final year of study during Summer 2024-25; and
- 3. Participate in one of the Eligible Programs specified below, and the duration should ideally be at least 6 weeks. (Students are also welcome to identify their own research project within our <u>exchange partners network</u> which is not listed below.)

# **Application:**

- 1. Interested students shall notify the School of Engineering at <u>egbho@ust.hk</u> about the research activity with an acceptance letter from the host institution by <u>31 May 2025</u>.
- 2. Successful applicants will receive approval confirmation emails from the School of Engineering in 2 weeks.

#### **Sponsorship:**

- 1. The research program must take place during Summer 2024-25 and should not overlap with the preceding spring term or the following fall term.
- 2. The sponsorship amounts are as follows:

3. Students must submit a budget plan including external funding (stupid, free accommodation, airfare, etc.) from the host, if any, for our consideration. The sponsorship amount may be deducted according to their external funding from a third party.

# **Conditions of Sponsorship:**

- 1. Students must complete the event satisfactorily with a completion letter from the host, and submit their pictures and report on describing the cultural experience to the School within one month of completion.
- 2. By accepting this sponsorship, students hereby give their consent for HKUST to use the pictures (or videos) and reports for reporting and publicity purposes.
- 3. The sponsorship will be withdrawn should students fail to complete the event for whatever reason.

# KAIST Visiting Student Researcher Program (KAIST VSR)

Date: All year round

Major: All

Application: At least 2 months prior to the start of the research at KAIST

Faculty/Project: Please refer to respective KAIST department websites

Budget:

- a. Registration Fee: USD 350 (Students from partner universities will be exempted from the registration fee), and
- b. Instruction fee for individual research: None to KRW 1,000,000. The instruction fee is decided by the professor in charge of the lab. Please inquire with the lab when applying.

# Approximate Expenses at a Glance

(Registration USD 350) + (Instruction USD 0 - 910) + (Dorm USD 92 - 285 per month) + (Deposit USD 92) = Maximum USD 1,637 on the first month

\* NOT including food and visa/alien registration card expenses.

\* It is recommend by the Korean Immigration Office to have a minimum of USD 592 (KRW 650,000) per month to live in Korea.

\* Students may be provided with a research stipend depending on the lab.
